EMERGENCY SERVICES FUND ~ COVID-19 RELIEF AID

We are committed to ensuring that the county's most vulnerable families have the support they need to weather the short- and long-term impacts of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak. In response to this pandemic, our Board has made additional funds available through our long-standing Emergency Services Fund. Businesses, organizations, and individuals have joined us to stand united by donating to this fund. These contributions will greatly extend help to St. Clair County residents as the community endures COVID-19 and recovers from the aftermath.
