**Brief Description:**

The School Success Program is a prevention program funded through Region 10 and Medicaid prevention dollars. This program is offered to students and families whom are Medicaid eligible and who have been identified by their school at chronically truant. Direct and indirect services are provided to the student and family within the home, school and community environments. A case worker will meet with the student and family to identify barriers and develop a person centered plan which focuses on improving daily school attendance and overall academic performance. This program is individually based and services are provided based on the needs identified throughout the assessment process and can be provided in any school in St. Clair County.

To access School Success Program services, a RESA level truancy hearing must be held with the St. Clair County Truancy officer and school administration.

The School Success Program is a volunteer program intended to reduce risk of continued violation of the Michigan Compulsory Attendance Law.
