**Brief Description:**

Program mission is to reduce barriers to a student's consistent attendance at school. Maintaining a successful home placement without disruption, and deferring the student from petition process are goals of the services provided. The service interventions are designed to reduce the incidence of behavioral, emotional or cognitive dysfunction, thus reducing the need for individuals to seek treatment through the public mental health system. Services provided are comprehensive, promote the safety and well being of the student and the family, meet the needs of the child and family in the home setting, and decrease the petition process. To defer the need for a formal court process initiation to address truant behaviors and to reduce barriers that may be hampering school attendance and success. By implementing prevention services that can assess, monitor, link and support strengths in the student and his or her parent/family as well as assist in areas that have growth potential in developing pro-social behaviors, coping mechanisms and problem solving skills.
